# RE: Terms | *Vulnerable Connection*

- Connection  $\longmapsto$  Being seen, heard and valued
- Knowledge (*da'ath*)  $\mapsto$  A perceptive skill or ability
- *Encounter* (*yada*)  $\longmapsto$  An intimate knowing by experience
- *Vulnerable*  $\longmapsto$  Risking uncertainly & exposure, naked
- *Intimacy*  $\longmapsto$  Sustained experience of a vulnerable connection. Abiding!

# *RE: The Seduction | DTR & W*

“God has an experience He is ***intentionally withholding*** from you. He does this because He does NOT want you to be ***equal with Him***. Naked, nakedness

# Deuteronomy 28:46–48 | *DTR&W*

[46] They shall be a sign and a wonder against you and your offspring forever. [47] Because you did not serve the LORD your God with joyfulness and gladness of heart, because of the abundance of all things, [48] therefore you shall serve your enemies whom the LORD will send against you, in hunger and thirst, in **nakedness**, and lacking everything. And he will put a yoke of iron on your neck until he has destroyed you.

Naked, nakedness

‘ārûm - עָרוּם

subtle, shrewd, **crafty**, sly, sensible, crafty,

shrewd, sensible, prudent

# Post Tree *Yada* | *DTR&W*

# Genesis 3:8 | *DTR&W*

**shema** = שָׁמַע - *Hear, listen, obey* | **Deut. 6:4-5**

**qôl** = קוֹל - *Voice* | **Ex. 19:19**

**YHWH** = יְהוָה - *The one who is embodied*

**ĕlōhîm** = אֱלֹהִים - *gods, rulers, judges, divine ones*

**hālak** = הָלַךְ - *to go, walk, come*

**gan** = גֶּן - *garden, enclosure*

**rûaḥ** = רוּחַ - *wind, breath, mind, spirit* | **Gen. 1:2**

**pānîm** = פְּנִים - *Face, presence* | **Ex. 33:11**



# Genesis 3:8 | *DTR&W*

[8] And they *shema* the *qôl* of the *YHWH ălôhîm* *hālak* in the *gan rûaḥ* of the day, and the man and his wife hid themselves from the *pānîm* of the *YHWH ălôhîm* among the trees of the *gan*.

# Genesis 3:8 | *DTR&W*

[8] And they ***hear, listened and obeyed*** the ***voice*** of the ***One God who is embodied walking*** in the ***enclosed lush space in the spirit*** of the day, and the man and his wife hid themselves from the ***face to face encounter*** of the ***One God who is embodied*** among the trees of the ***enclosed lush space***.

# The Consequence | *DTR & W*

## Loss of a Fathering influence in our lives

### 1. Identity

- Shame/nakedness
- “Self” aware

### 2. Protection

- Flee the Presence
- Irrational belief that we can hide from the Father

### 3. Provision

- Fig leaves = I can FIX this!
- Adam and Eve do not reconnect at the Father’s pursuit.
